#### NC 19/06 Nantmel School – Shortfall of Funds

The Chairman and Cllr Bowen brought to the attention of members the shortfall in budget for Nantmel School. The Clerk reported the following:

The Department for Communities and Local Government (DCLG) has confirmed that the appropriate sum for the purpose of section 137(4)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972 (the 1972 Act) for parish and town councils in England for 2016/17 is £7.42.

This allows the Community Council to spend £3954.86 (533 residents x £7.42) to be sent on Section 137 projects. Members agreed this would be insufficient to assist the budget.
