NC 27/14 **Minutes:**

NC 30/14 **Planning Applications:**

a) **P/2014/0507:** Full: Installation of single 500 kw wind turbine 77m to blade tip height and 50m to hub height, upgrading of existing access track, construction of new access track and associated infrastructure at Cefncynfal, Llanddewi for Oliver Penney. Seren Energy. **No objection.**

NC 31/14 **Correspondence:**

a) **Powys County Council – Nantmel School Governor**

Cllr Lewis explained that there had been a misunderstanding and there was no longer a vacancy for a Governor. Cllr Lewis' term will end in 2016.

b) **Powys County Council – Ranking Scheme for Undertaking Minor Works**

c) **Powys County Council – War Memorial**

Documentation had now been received stating the War Memorial ownership had been transferred to Nantmel Community Council on 14th June 1979.

The Clerk had looked into insuring the Memorial prior to the meeting. Within the existing Zurich policy the Council has All Risk (blanket) cover up to a total sum insured of £10,000. This matter was discussed by members.

Resolved: to include this item on the existing insurance policy.

The Clerk had been informed that there will be a service taking place to commemorate the beginning of World War 1. She will contact Idris Davies to establish details.

Members agreed to carry out some work at the Memorial and agreed to meet on Saturday 19th July at 9.30am to carry this out. Clerk to contact all members to inform them of this. Cllr R Lewis gave his apologies as he will be away on holiday.

Cllr Harris will remove the chain fencing for dipping and Cllr Morgan will spray the area with weed killer before 19th July.

d) Roger Williams/Kirsty Williams – Speed Limit – Trunk Roads

Requesting information on any required speed limits on trunk roads within the area.

Resolved: to request a speed limit of 50mph on A44 from Holy Oak to Cwmgwyiddol.
