As such, there won't be a huge amount of detail on this until further into the project's development. In terms of the area of benefit, that isn't determined yet, and is unlikely to be until post-consent.

Over the next few months, EDF Renewables will be conducting further events in the community. The next ones are likely to be in the summer, and will hopefully include more detail about matters such as grid route and proposed transport routes and access to site.
